

NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION AND NOISE WALL MEETING

The Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) will conduct a Public Information and Noise Wall Meeting for the proposed widening of Interstate 65 (I-65) between Trinity Lane and Dickerson Road in Davidson County, TN. This meeting is being held to inform the public of the impending project as well as to provide additional information about the noise barriers that are proposed. TDOT representatives will be available at the meeting to answer questions about the project.

A short presentation will be given and will include a brief overview of the project, information about the specific design elements proposed, details on the project schedule, as well as a discussion of the noise barrier design features (proposed location and noise barrier finish/ color). This meeting is also being held to satisfy the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).

The overall project is approximately 1.5 miles in length and will widen I-65 from six to ten lanes between Trinity Lane and Dickerson Road. This project will add two additional thru lanes in each direction within the project limits. After completion, the typical roadway cross-section will contain five, 12' traffic lanes in each direction with a 28' wide median with concrete barrier and 12' outside shoulders. I-24 eastbound to the I-65 southbound ramp will be widened to provide two 12' foot lanes. No additional right-of-way or easement will be required for this improvement.

This project will also include the construction of noise barriers along northbound I-65 from approximately 500' south of Lyndale Drive to the existing noise barrier south of Homestead Avenue, and along southbound I-65 from just south of Dickerson Pike to approximately 250' south of Richmond Hill Drive. The average noise barrier height will be 15'. Comments concerning the noise barriers' community side finish and color will be taken.
