

NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION AND NOISE WALL MEETING

The Tennessee Department of Transportation will conduct a Public Meeting on Thursday, March 1, 2012 at Goodlettsville City Hall, 105 South Main Street, Goodlettsville, TN 37072, to discuss the proposed noise barrier on Interstate 65 (I-65) in Davidson County, Tennessee.

The noise barrier will extend approximately 2,600' between Alta Loma Road and Vietnam Veterans Parkway (SR-386) next to the I-65 southbound lanes. This public meeting is being held to inform the community of the noise barrier design features, the proposed location, and discuss the noise barrier finish and color.

This meeting will be held from 6:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. during which time there will be a short informal presentation beginning at 6:15 p.m. and a brief question and answer period. The public is invited to ask questions and make comments during the meeting. Representatives of the department will be available to answer questions concerning the project.
