Each proposal must be accompanied by a Bidder Bond on the form contained in the proposal, from a Surety Company acceptable to the Greeneville – Greene County Airport Authority, or a cashier's check or certified check made payable to the Greeneville – Greene County Airport Authority, for not less than 5 percent of the total amount of the bid.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO BIDDERS: A Pre-Bid Conference has been scheduled for 2:00 p.m., local time, on Thursday, July 30, 2009, at the Greeneville-Greene County Municipal Airport, for the purpose of discussing the scope of the project and answering questions. Attendance at this conference by an appropriate contractor's representative is mandatory in order to be eligible to submit a bid.

All Bidders shall be licensed Contractors as required by the Contractors Licensing Act of 1976 of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee, and all amendments thereto in effect on the date of receipt of bids.

Envelopes containing proposals must be sealed and addressed to: Greeneville-Greene County Airport Authority, and marked for which project the proposal pertains. Also, the Contractor's name, classification, address, license number, expiration date and date and time of the bid opening shall be indicated on the envelope.

The Authority, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Acts of 1964 (42 U.S.C. 2000d) and 49 CFR, Part 26, Non-Discrimination in Federally Assisted Programs of the Department of Transportation, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that disadvantaged business enterprises are afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, sex, or national origin in consideration for and award.

The successful bidders will be required to furnish acceptable Performance and Payment Bonds in the amount of (100 percent) of the Contract Price for each bond. Contractors and Subcontractors Public Liability, Vehicle Liability and Property Damage Insurance will be required.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

Attention is called to the fact that the Contractors must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, creed, color, religion, national origin, and sex or handicap status.

The Authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any formalities in the bidding. The Authority does not discriminate on the basis of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, religion or handicap status in employment or the provisions of services.
