SR-15 (US-64) Southern Bypass
Meeting Date: February 17, 2009

The Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) is reviewing changes to the plan for SR-15 (US-64) bypass (also called the Southern Bypass). The original project plan was a four-lane roadway designed for higher speeds (60mph). The revised project plan is a lower speed, two-lane facility with landscaping and a multi-use path for pedestrians and bicycles. Roundabouts on the east and west ends of the revised project plan are designed to provide a "gateway" into Bolivar. Please answer the following questions and provide your input about the plans for this project. See Figure 1 for changes to the typical section.

1. Do you feel that the revised Southern Bypass design presented tonight is a better fit for your community? Why?

- No, I do not think the new design fits the original Purpose and Need for the project.

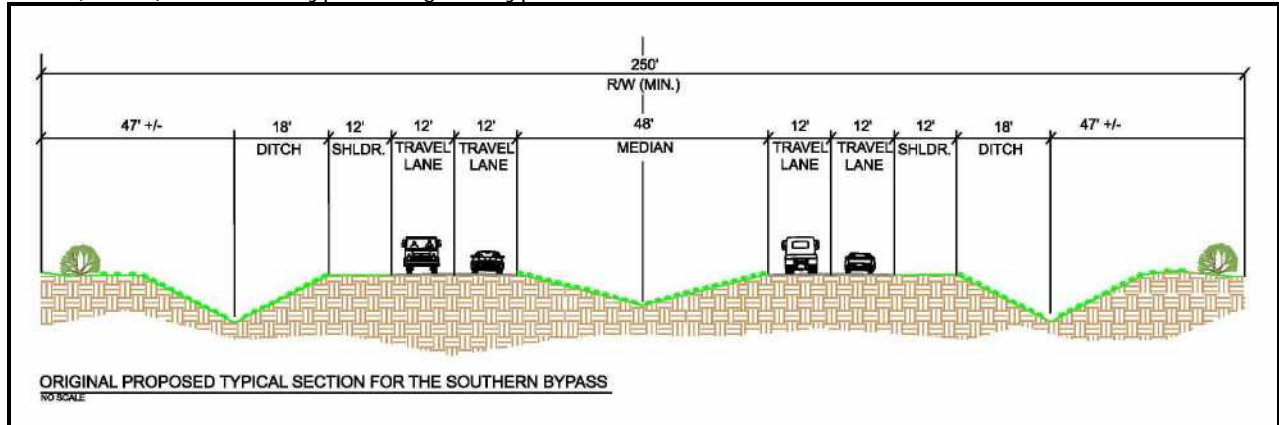
3. Will you use the multi-use path designed for pedestrians and bicycles along the Bypass?

- No, I will not use the multi-use path.

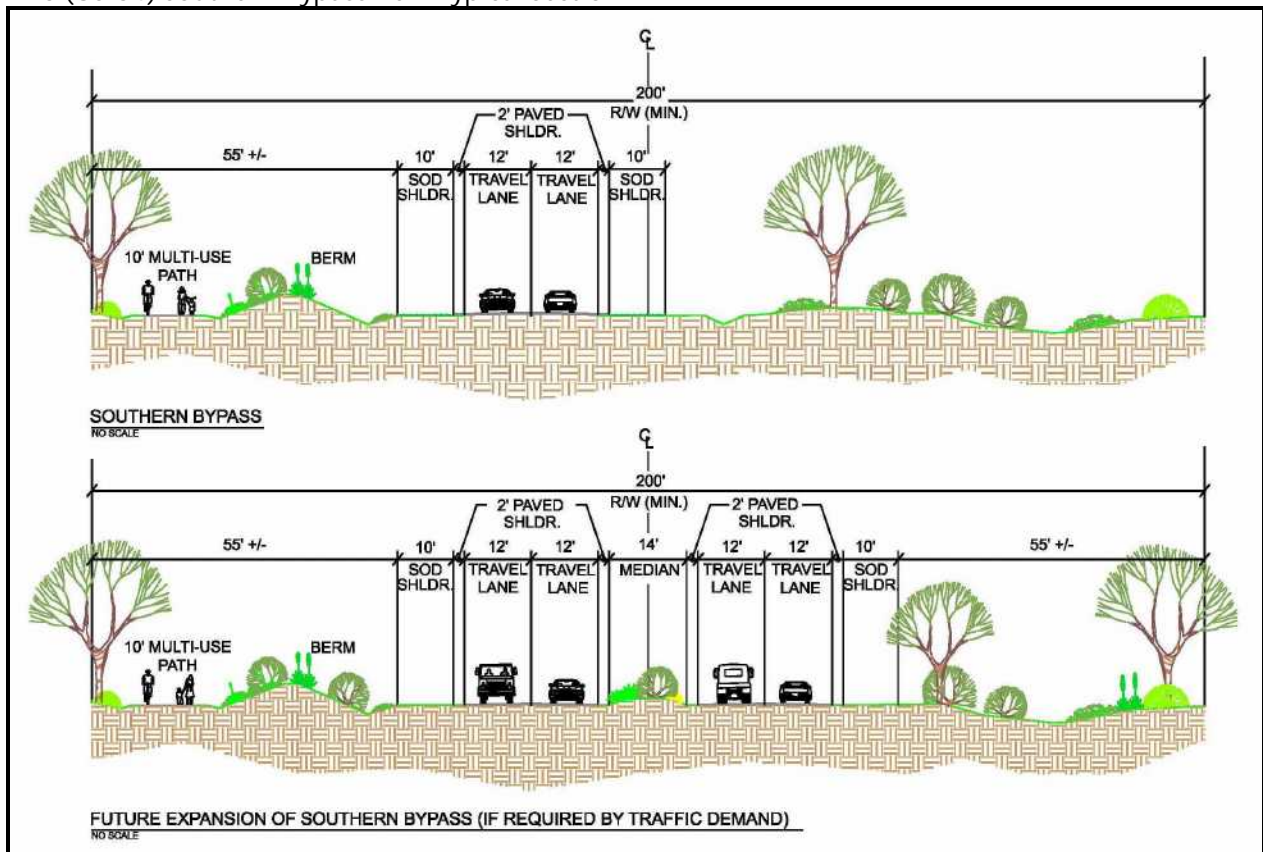
