



## Public Meeting Notice

The Tennessee Department of Transportation hereby advises the public of an informal Public Meeting to be held:

This meeting is being conducted to obtain public input for the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for **State Route 18 from Bolivar to State Route 100 in Hardeman County**. The public is invited to provide comments concerning the transportation needs for the area and the purposes for this corridor. This meeting will also provide opportunities to comment on environmental issues and concerns. A general map of the corridor is shown.

There will be a short presentation followed by a question and answer session. Representatives from the Department of Transportation will be available to answer questions and record comments. Aerial photographs will be displayed to aid in this process.
